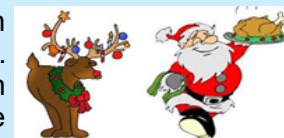
### Breakfast with Santa

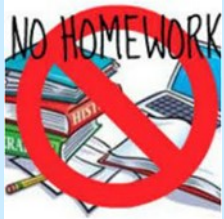
