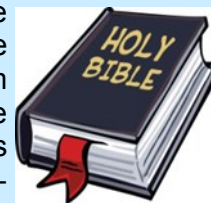
Middy Supervisor Vacancy

Christian Value – Wisdom

This half term the value we will be exploring is 'Wisdom'. The bible talks of wisdom as a gift from God (King Solomon asks for this gift - 1 Kings 3) and in the New Testament wisdom is one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12). Wisdom is different from just being clever. Often wise people have lots of experience and can give good advice to help us make difficult decisions. We will be thinking about how wisdom differs from knowledge, identifying the characteristics of someone who is wise and exploring how we experience and show wisdom. We will do this through sharing stories from the Bible as well as learning stories, fables, sayings and proverbs.
