SEND & Inclusion

Warwickshire County Council has extended their special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) Home to School Transport and SEND Service Offer consultation for an extra two weeks to give parents, carers and their families more time to have their say. The original consultation period was for 12 weeks, two of which covered the Christmas period. However, following feedback, the Council has listened to the views of parent carers and their families who would like more time to have their say. They have also asked for an executive summary of the consultation documents. In direct response to this, the consultation has now been extended to **Sunday 12 March 2023**.
