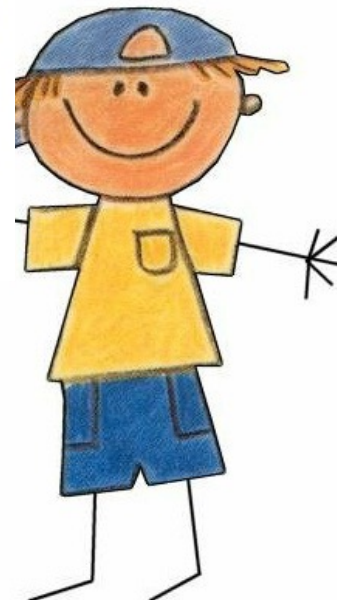

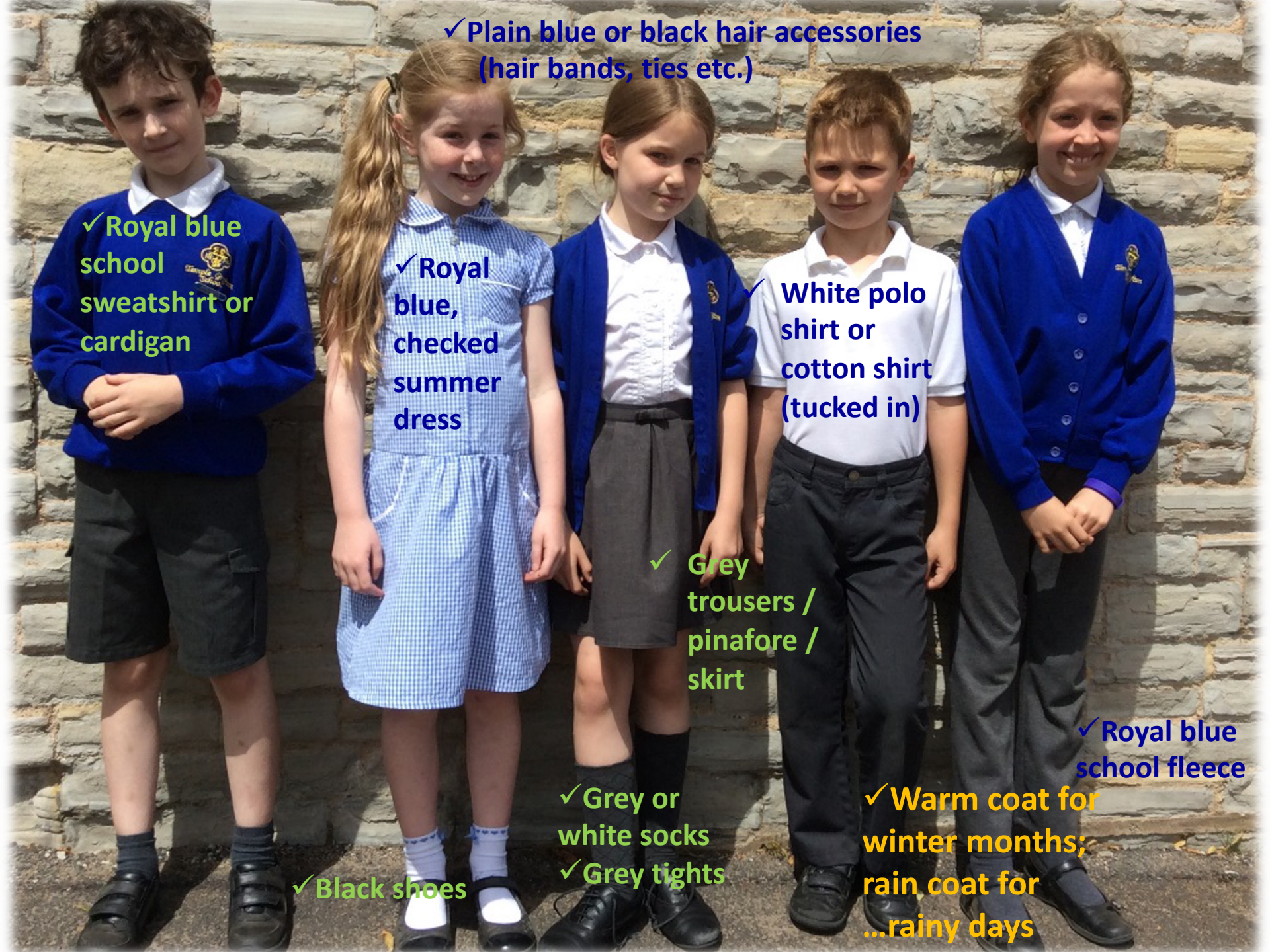

# Medical Matters

- Please keep medical information up-to-date
- If your child suffers from asthma or anaphylaxis, an inhaler or epi-pen **must be kept in school at all times**
- Sometimes children may need to take medicine following an illness. We are happy to support children to take their medicines, under supervision, providing the medication is:
  - in date
  - in its original packaging and clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage
  - and an authorisation form (available from the school office) has been completed

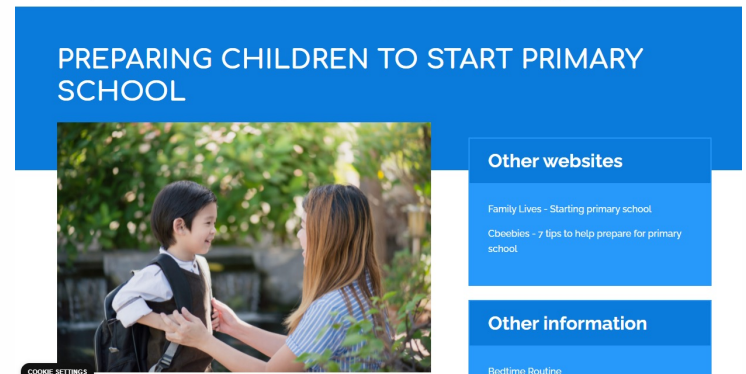
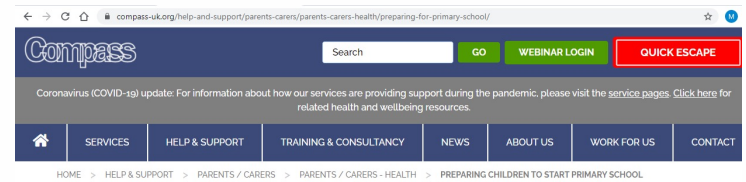
