Our Lead PE teacher, Mrs Davies-Campbell, has been leading an initiative with the express aim of inspiring a life-long love of movement whilst developing girls' personal, social, emotional and physical health and their understanding about the importance of being active throughout their lives.

The programme has been designed for girls by girls in response to data that suggests physical activity in girls starts to decline as they get older. The aim has been to train 6 of our Y5/6 girls who will then be leaders, inspiring our girls in Y3/4. The programme was successfully launched at an event in Leamington on the morning of 9<sup>th</sup>, January 2023.
