End of Year Reports

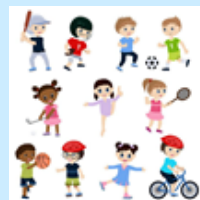
Next Wednesday we will be sending out the end of year school reports. Please check your children's book-bags to make sure they arrive home.
