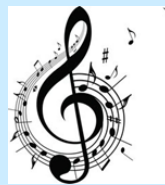

### Sports Day



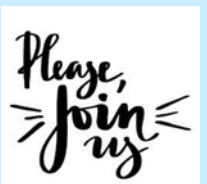
