**Minimising Contact** 

The children are coping well with the necessity for keeping their distance from one another. We have been reinforcing the expectations around social distancing, no touching and hand hygiene throughout the day with lots of praise and prompts. We would appreciate your help in reinforcing these key messages at home.



## **Footwear**



We would like all children to be wearing trainers if possible as they are more robust than black pumps for outdoor play. On days when it has rained the grass will be quite damp and pumps absorb the moisture leading to soggy feet!

Warm Layers

In line with the guidance, we are keeping the classroom windows open to ensure adequate ventilation when we are learning indoors. On days when the weather is cooler, it would be a good idea for children to have an extra warm layer to put on. This does not need to be school uniform, a jumper or sweatshirt would work well.



#### **Forest School**

We plan to take each group across to use the Forest School site and have set up a schedule as follows:
