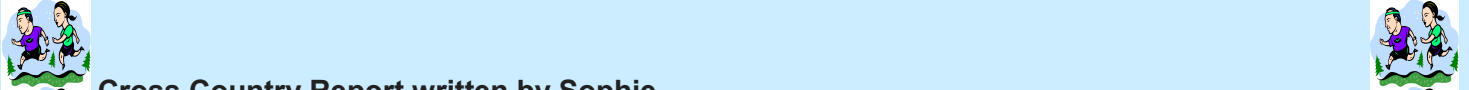
Stratford Girls' Grammar School / King Edward VI School

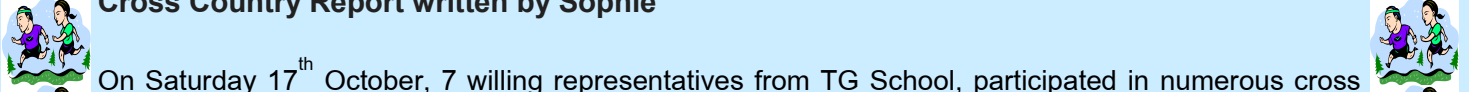

Family Service at St. Andrew's Church

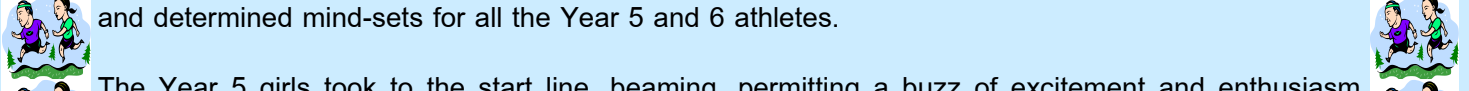
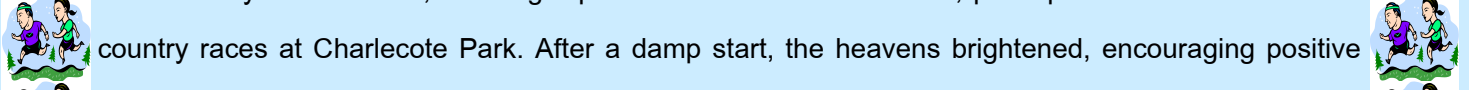
Father Kevin will now be holding a family service every Sunday at St. Andrew's Church at 9.15am. All families are very welcome to attend.



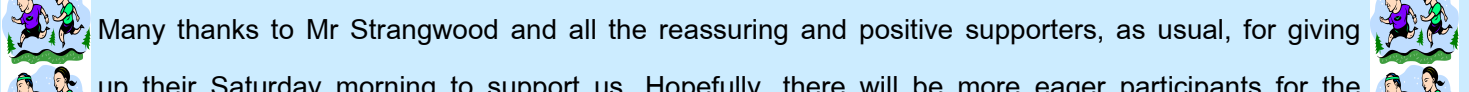
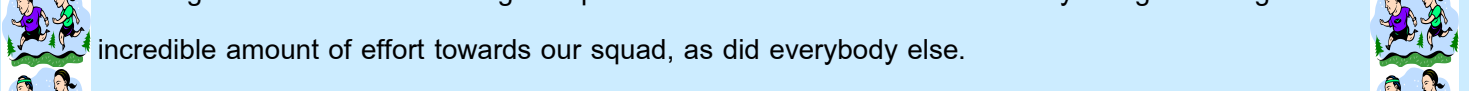
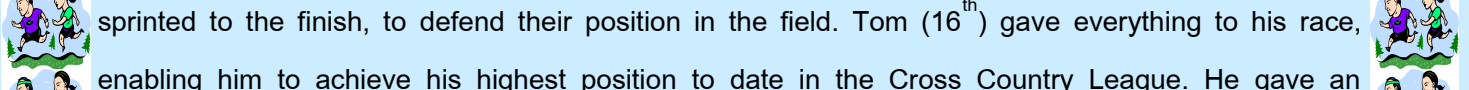
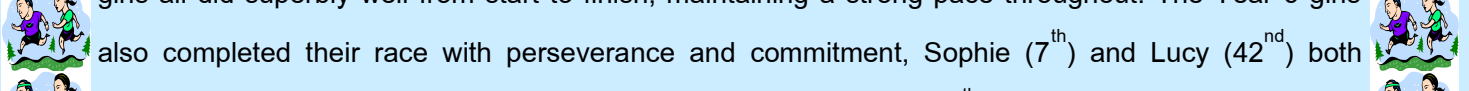
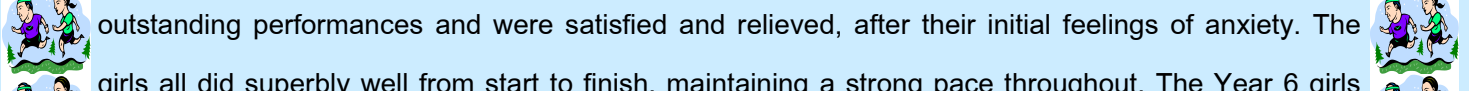
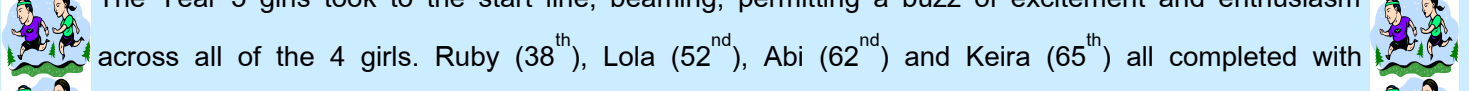
Cross Country Report written by Sophie



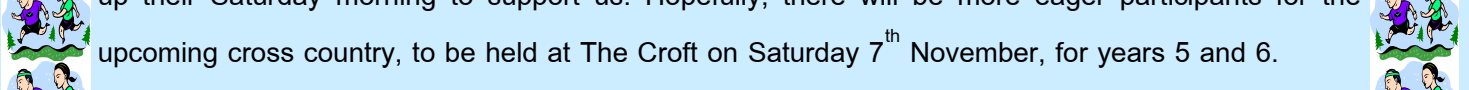
