Emergency Closure

We would recommend that all parents sign up to the Warwickshire County Council school closures notification system for parents. The new system only takes 30 seconds to sign up to via text and will then automatically send you a closure alert text once the school has notified them about an emergency closure. The new system allows you to subscribe to more than one school so will now be of benefit to those of you with older children at secondary school.

In order to register for the service for Temple Grafton C of E Primary School, text 'Schclosures 9373066 ON' to 07950 081082.
