School-to-School



On Thursday we welcomed Mr Wild, a teacher at Dunnington School, who came to talk to us about an exciting project he has planned for next year. In early 2017, Mr Wild will walk all 2180 miles of the Appalachian Trail on the east coast of the USA. Temple Grafton is one of six local primary schools who will be linking with Mr Wild as he prepares for and completes the challenge. Our children will have the opportunity to develop International links through all aspects of the curriculum.

The children in Class 3 will become part of an international collaboration to produce a trail journal that builds a portfolio of their work focusing on our local areas. Mr Wild will be coming back into school in the summer term to lead a writing workshop with the children to help them prepare their journal entries. Whilst he is completing the expedition, he will keep in contact with us through emails and a weekly video blog. Next week, the school council will be helping to plan a simple fundraising activity in support of the School-to-School project.
