More Sporting Stars!



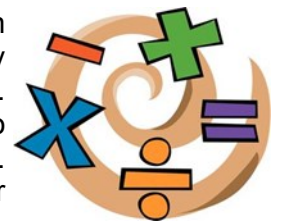

A library card for every child in Warwickshire

Earlier this year Warwickshire County Councillors unanimously backed a motion to enable every primary school child to receive a personalised library card. This will support work in school to encourage a love of books, reading and informal learning among pupils. Warwickshire Library Service will be issuing the cards in schools during the autumn term 2014.

In order to issue pupils with their individual named library cards, the Library Service needs to hold the name, address and date of birth of the pupils. This information will be collected securely via the County Council's ICT Development Service, and will only be used for the purposes of assigning a library card to each child. All information is held by the Library Service in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

The new cards will replace any existing library card held by the child (existing loans will be transferred to the new card).

If as a parent/guardian you wish to opt out of this scheme and do not want your child to receive a library card or if you require more information, please contact school as soon as possible. If you are happy for your child to have a card, you need do nothing!
