Sporting Champions!

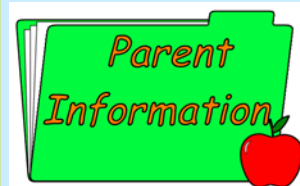

SATS Parent Information Sessions

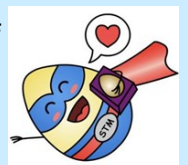
