Parent Survey



Key Worker Childcare



A reminder that critical worker childcare provision will end on Thursday 16th July for both the Crucial Crew and Key Worker Kids groups.

We are planning to have a party day on the final Thursday and will be arranging a special lunch and snacks for the children; we would like to ask for a contribution of £3 towards the costs – payments to be made through School Money please. All children who attend Key Worker Kids or Crucial Crew are welcome to be in school on Thursday 16th even if this is not one of their regular days to be in school.

Forest School

We plan to take each group across to use the Forest School site again this week. Please note the changes to the schedule:

Year 6 Tuesday

Key Worker Kids Wednesday

Crucial Crew Thursday

Our advice to families is that we would prefer children to be dressed in a long sleeved top and long trousers/leggings when they visit forest school. Having arms and legs covered helps to minimise the risk of stings and scratches which are uncomfortable for the children and also necessitate close contact between staff and children to administer 1st Aid.

Drop-off and Pick-up Windows

A reminder that in the event that you arrive early, we would appreciate it if you would wait inside your car until it is time for your window to start, this way we can maintain the separation between the bubbles.

We would also like to remind families that we have asked you to leave promptly once you have dropped off and collected your children so that the pathway outside school is kept clear for people to have the space to circulate safely and to minimise contact between the class bubbles.
