All children who attend Key Worker Kids or Crucial Crew are welcome to be in school on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> even if this is not one of their regular

Our advice to families is that we would prefer children to be dressed in a long sleeved top and long trousers/leggings when they visit forest school. Having arms and legs covered helps to minimise the risk of stings and scratches which are uncomfortable for the children and also necessitate close contact between staff and children to administer 1<sup>st</sup> Aid.

### **Drop-off and Pick-up Windows**

A reminder that in the event that you arrive early, we would appreciate it if you would wait inside your car until it is time for your window to start, this way we can maintain the separation between the bubbles.

We would also like to remind families that we have asked you to leave promptly once you have dropped off and collected your children so that the pathway outside school is kept clear for people to have the space to circulate safely and to minimise contact between the class bubbles.
