The course will take place over four days, during school hours, starting on Monday, 16th May and finishing on Thursday, 19th May.


Attached you will find the details of what your child will need, including a roadworthy cycle, a helmet, clothing suitable for the activity and all weathers, and a completed consent form.

Please refer to the paperwork form Outspoken for further details before completing and returning the consent form to school by Tuesday, 3rd May. Children will need to bring their bicycles to school with them on the morning of Monday, 16th May and will be able to leave them here until Thursday, 19th; we will keep them secure in the school hall overnight.
