Katie Potter (James' big sister) for the 11years+ category who magically managed to stack 7 conkers one on top of the other!

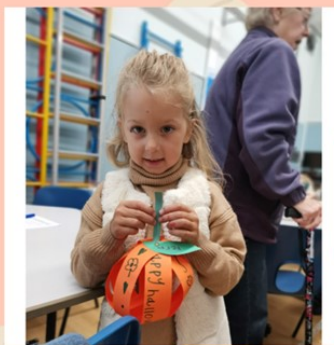
Well done everyone, please see Kim for your prizes and a huge 'Thank You' again for everyone that helped out.
