**Ref: Mary Arden’s Farm Tudor’s Alive Workshop Class 3 Trip – Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023**

Dear Class 3 Parents and Carers,

To support next term’s history topic, ‘Local significant individual William Shakespeare and life in Tudor times’, we have organised a visit to **Mary Arden’s Farm on Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023**, where the children will learn about different aspects of everyday life in Tudor times.

- This will be a whole day trip. We ask that you drop the children off as normal at 8.45am. We will be leaving school around 9:30am and return to school in time for the end of the school day. All children will need to bring a packed lunch; a small bag or rucksack to put their lunch and water bottle in is also a good idea as the children will be responsible for carrying their own belongings. Please do not include fizzy drinks or yoghurts.
- The children will dress in school uniform but due to the potential for ticks in the long grass, children are recommended to wear long trousers or knee-length (not ankle) socks to keep their legs covered.
- The workshop will include walking outdoors around the site. Children should wear sensible shoes and clothing that offers suitable protection against the possibility of cold and/or wet weather which could also lead to some wet and muddy pathways.

In order for the trip to take place, we need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £8.50 per child. There is no obligation for you to pay, but if we do not receive contributions from the majority of the class, we will have to cancel. Please speak to the school office, in confidence, if paying will cause a problem for you. The cost of the trip is in line with our charging policy. Payments will be set up on School Money or you can send cash or a cheque into school with the reply slip. Cheques to be made payable to Temple Grafton School.

To support us with the organisation and planning for this trip, we would be grateful if you would complete and sign the attached slip and return it to school by Monday, 17<sup>th</sup>, April Thank you for your support for this visit which I am sure will provide a wealth of experience and learning opportunities for your children.
