Parking & speed around school

I'm here again with a polite but very sincere plea regarding parking and the speed at which we travel though the village.



Parking: Please avoid parking in those areas indicated,

but also, on the corners of the crossroads and across our neighbour's driveways. Such actions reduce visibility, causing families crossing to have to step out on to the road to see if traffic is approaching, and block neighbours from entry and access to their homes.

Speed: The speed limit approaching school is 60 miles an hour and the one outside school is 30. In my opinion, both are ludicrously high. Our families who walk to school are able to tell me first-hand how vulnerable they feel when cars pass, many of whom exceed the 30 miles an hour limit in their haste to reach school on time. The pathway is narrow; this is further exacerbated at this time of year due to overhanging trees and bushes. We are at real risk of a child being caught and pulled into the road by a speeding car. Please consider the implications of this, particularly when two cars are passing.


