- Black flat shoes (no trainers, high heeled shoes, boots, sling backed trainers or open sandals)

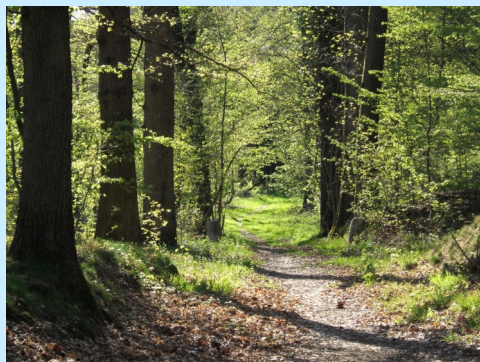
Other:
