Dear Class 2 Parents

To support this terms topic 'Ticket to Ride, we have organised a visit to the Wythall Transport Museum, on Wednesday 6th May. The visit will include rides on a vintage bus and a miniature steam train and the opportunity to explore a range of vintage vehicles.

This will be a whole day trip. We will leave school at 9.30am and return to school in time for the end of the school day. All children will need to bring a packed lunch for this day. A small bag or rucksack to put their lunch and water bottle in is also a good idea. We would like the children to be dressed in the school shirts and sweatshirts / cardigans; a comfortable pair of trousers/ shorts (not jeans) and comfortable sturdy footwear (trainers would be ideal). As many of the activities will be taking place outdoors, it will also be essential to provide a waterproof coat.

In order for the trip to take place, we need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £5.50 per child. This represents half of the cost for the full day; the other half is to be paid from PTA funds. There is no obligation for you to pay, but if we do not receive contributions from the majority of the class, we will have to cancel. Please speak to me or Mrs Hendry, in confidence, if paying will cause a problem for you. The cost of the trip is in line with our charging policy. Payments will be set up on school money or you can send cash or a cheque into school with the reply slip.

To support us with the organisation and planning for this trip, we would be grateful if you would complete and sign the attached slip and return it to school by Thursday 1st May. Thank you for your support for this visit which I am sure will provide a wealth of experience and learning opportunities for your children.
