## **Dear Parents**

We have organised an Educational visit for Class Two to Coughton Court, a National Trust property, on Wednesday November 4<sup>th</sup> 2015. The visit will include The Gunpowder Trail, House, Tower (weather permitting), Gardens and the two Churches. This exciting itinerary, run by the National Trust staff, will support and enrich the Curriculum work we have planned in History, Geography and Literacy.

This will be a whole day trip. We will leave school at 9.30am and return to school at 2.30pm, therefore, packed lunches will be needed for this day. We suggest that the children have a small bag or rucksack in which to carry their lunch and water bottle. School uniform should be worn and all children should wear comfortable sturdy footwear (trainers would be ideal). Girls may wear dark trousers if preferred. As there will be an element of outdoor activity it will also be essential to provide a warm, waterproof coat.

In order for the trip to take place we need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £5.00 per child. We are grateful to our PTA who are subsidising the cost of the trip. There is no obligation for you to pay, but if we do not receive contributions from the majority of the class, we will have to cancel. Please speak to either of us, in confidence, if paying will cause a problem for you. The cost of the trip is in line with our charging policy.

Payments will be set up on School Money or you can send cash or a cheque into school with the reply slip. Cheques to be made payable to Temple Grafton School. To support us with the organisation and planning for this trip, could you return the slip to school by Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> October.

Thank you for your support for this visit which we are sure will provide a wealth of experience and learning opportunities for your children.
