Dear Parents

On Monday 8th of February we will be holding our annual TG Panto Day.

For families new to our school, this is the day when we enjoy a visit from the theatre company, M and M Productions, who transform our hall into a mini theatre and perform a pantomime for the whole school. This year they will be entertaining us with Aladdin. We are intending to use the production as the starting point for a creative writing week in which all children across the school will be involved.

To add to the day, we ask all children and staff to come dressed up as a character from a pantomime or a traditional fairy story. Please bear in mind when planning costumes that the children will still be going outside at playtimes (weather permitting) and will need to have appropriate footwear for running around outdoors. Please also note that because the hall is not available over lunchtime on Panto Day, we ask that all children bring a packed lunch to eat. Monday 8th February was crossed out on the Teddy Bear Corner form so no hot dinners have been booked for that day.

We are very grateful to our PTA committee who have agreed to support this event by covering 50% of the invoice cost. As a result, we are seeking a voluntary contribution of £4 per child. There is no obligation for you to pay, but if we do not receive contributions from the majority of the classes, we will have to cancel. Please speak to one of us or Mrs Hendry, in confidence, if paying will cause a problem for you. The cost is in line with our charging policy. Payments will be set up on School Money or you can send cash or a cheque (payable to Temple Grafton School) into school in a named envelope.
