Dear TG Families

I am writing to update you all on changes we will be making to our provision for children in school from next Monday. All schools have been asked to prioritise providing childcare for children of critical workers and as the lockdown is easing, and more people are returning to work outside of their homes, the demand for critical worker childcare at TG has increased. As a result, we are now at a point where we need to create a second 'bubble' to accommodate the children safely. In order to be able to staff this new 'bubble', we will be joining our two Year 1 'bubbles' into one group, the Rainbow Stars. Our updated arrangements are in line with the Government guidance and we believe are the best option to enable us to continue supporting Year 1 children in school until 2<sup>nd</sup> July.

The Rainbow Stars will be taught by Miss Taylor and will be based in Class 3 as this is the bigger of the two rooms so can more easily accommodate the group and Mrs Yorke will be responsible for the new key worker group, the Crucial Crew, who will be based in Class 2.

The pick-up and drop-off windows for each group will be as follows:
