Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be able to tell you that Class 1 will be starting Recovery Curriculum Forest School, on our site just across the road, from next week. It will be on Wednesday mornings, starting on 16th September, until further notice.

What do the children need to wear?

It is important that the children are comfortable and not worried about getting their clothes dirty. We don't let the weather stop us having fun but it is important that we are suitably dressed. Thanks to the PTA, school are able to supply waterproof dungarees and a waterproof jacket but the children will need warm layers to go underneath and suitable footwear. Suitable footwear might include old trainers/walking boots; wellies if the weather has been especially wet. Hats and gloves are also a good idea for the chillier days. If we are fortunate enough to have a warm Autumn, children still need to have long sleeved tops and long trousers to keep them safe.
