Reference: settling in adjustments – Forest school and change of P.E date

Dear Class 2 Parents and Carers,

Your children are impressing us more each day with their capacity to manage the 'new normal' of the school day as well as getting to know new members of their teaching team.

To support them in this, we have planned a few adjustments. **We will be moving Friday's P.E. session to Thursday** as Class 2 will be having their Forest School session on Friday mornings, **starting from next Friday, 18th September.**

On Wednesday and Thursday, therefore, the children should come to school in their P.E. kits, and on Friday, they will need to be dressed for a morning in the forest.

What do the children need to wear for Forest School Fridays?

It is important that the children are comfortable and not worried about getting their clothes dirty. We don't let the weather stop us but it is important that we are suitably dressed. We are not able to provide waterproofs due to Covid restrictions and we would ask that all your children should carry them in a named bag in the event of very wet weather. All children will need to wear long sleeves, full-length trousers, sturdy shoes and warm layers. Suitable footwear might include old trainers/walking boots; wellies if the weather has been especially wet. Hats and gloves are also a good idea for the chillier days.
