Dear Parents and Carers

Following last night's announcement regarding the closure of schools, I am writing to confirm arrangements for the delivery of remote learning.

Remote learning will start from tomorrow morning and your child's class teacher will be in contact to let you know the structure of your child's day of learning. This will be designed to follow that of a regular school day as closely as possible. The children of critical workers in school will be receiving the same provision. Your child(ren)'s class teacher(s) will ensure that they have one live session with their class each day to discuss their work and address misconceptions.

It is more important than ever that all our children can maintain the routine of the school day and it is our expectation that children will complete all the work set by their teachers. Class teachers will be closely monitoring children's engagement with the learning provision so that they can track progress.

If any families are having difficulty accessing the learning due to a lack of devices or connectivity issues, please contact school as we may be able to help.

Thank you for your support with this - the fewer children making the journey to school, and the fewer children in educational settings, the lower the risk that the virus can spread and infect vulnerable individuals in wider society.
