

The Learning Project Overview Information for Parents

Why have Learning Projects been created?

In preparation for full school closure, Learning Projects have been created and adapted by teachers to maximise learning opportunities for children whilst they are at home. We acknowledge that we cannot replace the high quality education that your children receive in school; however, we have focused on creating work that can be completed during the school closure period.

What are the aims of the Learning Projects?

- To create age specific learning opportunities for primary school children.
- To create a resource for parents that is easy to access and use - the focus is on parents being able to help deliver the content or children accessing it independently.
- Key learning is linked to the National Curriculum.
- To enable children to continue with their learning at home during an enforced shutdown.
- To enable families to focus on a joint topic and theme to promote family wide learning.
- To provide structure and focus to each day that an enforced shutdown occurs.
- To centralise online learning resources and links into an easy to manage format for families.

How do I use the Learning Projects?

Each week we will be emailing out the learning projects to families on a Friday for the following week. The aim is for you to complete a minimum of two hours of learning a day with your child but this is very much your parental choice and you may wish for your child to do more or less.

What happens if my child finds the learning too difficult?

Our first piece of advice to parents is that ALL children find elements of learning challenging at times so try not to worry if your child becomes stuck and you cannot explain it to them. If this happens then make a note of what they found hard and move onto another learning activity.

The teachers will respond to emails via the following addresses between **10:00am – 11:00am** in the morning and **2:00pm-3:00pm** in the afternoon should you have any questions relating to the work set.
