<p><b>Write a thank you letter for someone!</b> Think of someone that helps you and write a short letter to them to say thank you.</p>	<p><b>Get building!</b> How tall can you make your tower? You could use lego, duplo, blocks or something else.</p>	<p><b>Create a weather and nature diary!</b> Each day have a look out the window and draw a picture of what you can see! Is the sun shining? Are there any animals you can see outside? What else?</p>	<p><b>Make a reading den!</b> Find somewhere cosy, snuggle down with your favourite blankets, pillows and teddies and read your favourite book!</p>
<p><b>Use a sock to create a sock puppet!</b> Can you create your very own puppet using an old sock? You could put on a show for someone!</p>	<p><b>Create your own register for your teddies!</b> Make a list of all the names of your teddies. You could do a register each morning and afternoon to ensure they are all there!</p>	<p><b>Play a board game!</b> Do you have any board games lying around at home? Have a go at playing it with your family!</p>	<p><b>Do something kind for someone!</b> Could you say something nice to someone in your family? Could you help them with any jobs around the house?</p>
<p><b>You've got talent!</b> Celebrate all the things you are good at and write a list to share with your family.</p>	<p><b>Design and make an obstacle course!</b> Have a go at creating your own obstacle course in the house or in the garden. How fast can you complete it?</p>	<p><b>Keep moving!</b> Make up a dance routine to your favourite song!</p>	<p><b>Storytime – read out loud!</b> Read your book to someone in your family. Talk about your favourite parts from the book. Did you have a favourite character? Why?</p>
<p><b>Get sketching!</b> Use a mirror to draw your very own self-portrait! Have a look at the colour of your eyes, your hair, your skin etc. Then have a go at drawing a portrait of someone in your family. Do they have the same colour eyes or hair?</p>	<p><b>Junk modelling!</b> Collect and recycle materials including yoghurt pots, toilet rolls and boxes and see what you can create with them!</p>	<p><b>Draw a map of your journey to school!</b> Have a think about the things that you pass on your way to school. Do you go over a bridge? Do you walk past any trees? Create a map with all of these things on!</p>	<p><b>Treasure hunt!</b> Hide something in your house or your garden and draw a treasure map for someone in your family to help them find it!</p>
<p><b>Write a postcard to Miss Harvey!</b> Let her know what you've been up to and what you like best about being in Class 1!</p>	<p><b>Get baking!</b> What would you like to bake? Look up a recipe of your favourite food and have a go at making it in the kitchen!</p>	<p><b>Sign your autograph!</b> Write your name on pieces of paper and give them to your teddies or toys!</p>	<p><b>Rhyming game!</b> Play a back-and-forth rhyming game with someone in your family!
