Re: Y6 transition arrangements

Dear Parents,

We have today received confirmation from all our transition schools that they will be complying with Warwickshire County Council's advice and holding their transition days virtually. The move comes in support of the Government's strategy to mitigate the risk posed by the Delta variant; numbers of children from separate primary schools coming together could lead to further community spreading.

This is obviously disappointing; however, it is anticipated that all the high schools will be making plans to offer virtual transition arrangements. We know that Alcester Academy will be holding their day on-line on the 9th July, but as yet we have not been made aware of the final dates for other schools – it may well be that we hear this from you before we hear it from them and so would ask that you pass any dates you receive to us, please.

Last year, most of our Y6 children were able to hold their virtual transition day from home. This may not be possible this year for many of you, and so we will ensure resource and space is made available for this to take place in school. Please email the office admin3066@welearn365.com to let us know your preference.

We are continuing to make plans to ensure we have our Leavers' Service on the morning of the last day, Tuesday, 20th July, just for our Y6 families. On the evening before, Monday, 19th July, we are aiming to hold our socially distanced 'football-rounders', BBQ and children-and-teachers only water fight. I will update you with more details nearer the time.

Naturally, all of these plans are subject to the roadmap, and both Government and WCC advice.
