Roof

Sections of the roof of our school building are badly in need of repair and to this end we have engaged contractors to replace the flat roof. The project will commence on Wednesday, 21st July with the erection of scaffolding and should be completed in three weeks. Ice Roofing will be on site between 7:00/7:30 each morning and 4:30 in the afternoon.
